NonStop Entertainment does Grand Cannes Slam

For the second year in a row NonStop Entertainment acquires the Palme d'Or winner, this year THE CLASS by Laurent Cantet. The Grand Prix winner GOMORRAH and five other high profile features are also acquired by NonStop Entertainment.

NonStop Entertainment is proud to announce seven new acquisitions at the recently closed Cannes Film Festival.

Adding the Palme d'Or winner 2008 -THE CLASS, the Grand Prix winner GOMORRAH, JOHNNY MAD DOG awarded with the Un Certain Regard sections' Hope Prize, the applauded Korean debut THE CHASER, the French drama success SUMMER HOURS with Juliette Binoche, THE PRIVATE LIVES OF PIPPA LEE featuring Keanu Reeves and Robin Wright Penn, and the innovative thriller HUSH produced by Warp X.

NonStop Entertainment acquired the following titles at the Cannes Film Festival 2008:

THE CLASS (Entre les murs) acquired from Memento Sales. Winner of the Palme d'Or 2008 and directed by Laurent Cantet (Vers le sud).

François and his fellow teachers prepare for a new year at a high school in a tough neighbourhood. Neither stuffy nor severe, his extravagant frankness often takes the students by surprise. But his classroom ethics is put to the test when his students begin to challenge his teaching methods. GOMORRAH, acquired from Fandango Portabello Sales. Grand Prix winner from Matteo Garrone, based on a novel with the same name. Power, money and blood are the "values" that the residents of the Province of Naples and Caserta, have to face every day. They hardly ever have a choice, and are almost always forced to obey the rules of the "system", the Camorra.

NonStop Entertainment is distributing GOMORRAH in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland and Iceland.

JOHNNY MAD DOG, acquired from TF1 International. The debut from director Jean-Stephane Sauvaires participated in the Un Certain Regard section and was awarded with the Hope Prize. Johnny, 15, is a Liberian kid-soldier armed to the hilt, inhabited by the mad dog he dreams of becoming. Most of the actors in the film are former soldiers. Produced by Matthieu Kassovitz. NonStop Entertainment is distributing JOHNNY MAD DOG in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland and Iceland.

THE CHASER acquired from Finecut. A raw thriller debut from one of Korea's most applauded new directors Na Hong-Jin, Ex-detective pimp Jung-ho is angry because his girls keep disappearing without clearing their debts. When he discovers that a serial killer is killing his employees he starts a violent chase after the murderer.

NonStop Entertainment is distributing THE CHASER in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, Iceland and the Baltics.

SUMMER HOURS (Heure d'été, L) acquired from MK2. Beautiful family drama by the French celebrated director Olivier Assayas with Juliette Binoche (Chocolat, The English Patient) in the leading part. Two brothers and a sister witness the disappearance of their childhood memories when they must relinquish the family belongings to ensure their deceased mother's succession.

NonStop Entertainment is distributing SUMMER HOURS in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland and Iceland.

HUSH acquired from Pathe International. The feature film debut from writer/director Mark Tonderai and the third film to shoot from Warp X's production slate. The taut suspense thriller tracks a deadly game of cat and mouse on a deserted motorway, when Zakes Abbot's girlfriend disappears at a service station shortly after he narrowly avoids a collision with a truck.
